



Trailer Requirements Prior to Loading

Buffalo Creek Mills (2017) Inc. requires all transport companies to ensure the following:

I agree to ensure that:

Any vessel will

- Be accompanied with at least 1 past load history
- Be free of broken components (e.g., glass, wood, etc.), chemical or odorous residues.
- Be dry, of sound condition & clean of previous load or hazardous residues, as in the following:
 - Floors swept clean, free of pooling water and/or ice, and grease/oil
 - Sidewalls free of previous debris, grease/oil stains, and free of threat to damage cargo
 - Free of leaks/holes in floor, sidewalls, tarp/roof, and seals (i.e., hopper gates/trailer doors)

Hopper Trailers will

- Be accompanied with documented wash-out if previous load contained:
 - Fertilizers or Treated Seeds/Additives, or contained strong odors
 - Known food allergens: soy, mustard
 - Wheat, Triticale, Barley, Spelt, Rye if contracted to haul Gluten-free product
 - Conventional grain or GMOs (e.g., corn, canola) if contracted to haul Organic product

Dry Vans will

- Be free of damage to doors and door hinges
- Be dry if washed out & provide proof of wash-out upon arrival (wash ticket)
- Be free of interior walls consisting of wood
- Come provided with strap anchors at the front and a minimum of 2 straps for use to anchor load

If transporting finished product, my company will maintain security of shipment by remaining with vessel in the event of a roadside breakdown, accident or overnight stop.
